Any exterior home projects must be submitted to the board for HOA approval. Although we have 30 days to respond, we almost always respond immediately. Keep in mind that unapproved work can violate our by-laws and possibly cause fines, penalties, and a reversal in the work that was performed. We've seen new roofs, windows, painting, and other of new work done on houses, much of which was not approved. Please do not put your work at risk simply because it was not run past the board.
